

This term in Year 1 we will be learning...

Literacy

Children will be taught Literacy on a daily basis with an hour lesson each day. We will continue to follow the Read Write Inc program. Children will be taught Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar on a daily basis. We will revisit prefixes and suffixes and how to punctuate sentences correctly using full stop, exclamation mark and question mark. Writing skills will also be taught through other subject areas within the topic.

Numeracy

Children will continue developing their skills in counting and using practical strategies for addition and subtraction. We will revisit number formation and learn how to accurately write the numbers up to 100 in digits. We will revisit writing numbers to 20 in words. We will be revisiting counting in 2s, 5s, 10s to 100 forwards and backwards. We will continue to develop our understanding of how to answer word problems for calculations such as multiplication and division. We will be looking at measuring using units of measurements to record for capacity, weights, time and lengths.

Art and DT

Children will have the opportunity to develop their design skills by creating their own pieces of art similar to traditional art work from the countries we explore. They will explore foods from around the world and this will link into healthy eating.

Geography

In geography children will explore the world, looking at countries, continents and oceans. The children will look at both human and natural features of the countries. The children will begin to make comparisons between where they live and other countries around the world. They will have the opportunity to use world maps and atlases. The children will be contributing to the topic by choosing where we will 'visit'; therefore I am unable to state the specific countries we will be exploring until after the holidays.

Music

In music children will listen to and perform a range of music from around the world.

P.E
