

This half term in Year 1 we will be learning...

Literacy

Children will be taught Literacy on a daily basis. Children will continue to follow the Read Write Inc programme. We will continue to develop our lowercase letters and capital letter formation and focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar skills. We will be learning how to write letter, non-chronological reports and narratives. Children will also apply their writing skills will through other subject areas within the topic.

Numeracy

Children will continue developing their skills in number, counting on and back, and calculating as well as using practical strategies for addition, subtraction and multiplication. They will also explore money, measures, shapes and problem solving. They will continue to learn by heart number facts such as number bonds to 10 and 20 and doubling. They will also develop their time telling skills at O'clock and half past the hour.

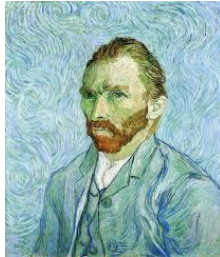
Art and DT

In Art children will explore the work of the famous artists Vincent Van Gogh and. They will explore form, colour, light and shade. The children will use a range of joining techniques in DT to create a model rocket and steam engine.

History

Music
