

Literacy

Children will be taught Literacy on a daily basis with an hour and a half lesson each day. Children will continue to follow the Read Write Inc program. We will continue to develop our cursive letters and capital letter formation. The children will have the opportunity to practise their dictionary work and learn how to put words into alphabetical order. This term children will be developing their creative side by writing their own adventure stories. Children will also develop their skills at editing and improving their own work. Writing skills will also be taught through other subject areas within the topic. e.g informative and instructional writing

Science

In Science children will be learning about plants, trees and looking at the weather whilst on our adventures visiting different parts of the world.

Numeracy

Children will learn how to record and compare time, length, weight and capacity. We will revisit fractions and look at finding half and quarter for both shape and number. Children will revisit time, looking at problems related to earlier and later.

We will improve our understanding of problem solving; such as missing number problems and word problems linked to addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will revisit number facts as the children need to be able to recall number facts off by heart!

R.E

In R.E. we will be learning about Judaism. We will look at the importance and meaning of Shabbat and Hanukkah for the Jewish people.

P.E

Children will be developing their skills in athletics.

Art and DT


We will be looking at landscape art by famous artists and have a chance to create our own masterpiece. There will also be a focus on sculpture where we will design and create a tree.

In Geography children will develop their knowledge about locations around the world. The children will make comparisons between locations by looking at both physical and human factors. The children will also have the opportunity to explore their local environment. We will be looking at maps and children will be using these to explore the village.
