RAISING STANDARDS OF PUPIL PROGRESS AND ACHIEVEMENT

- To raise standards of attainment and progress in Reading, particularly in the number of underachieving learners reaching the 'Expected or better' grading and to show a greater impact upon Writing;
- To raise standards of attainment and progress in Maths, particularly the number of girls reaching the 'Exceeding' grading.

IMPROVING QUALITY OF TEACHING

- To ensure quality first teaching for all learners with a particular focus on the Reading into Writing sequence;
- To explore how different teaching methods can enable learners to develop an independent approach to learning and to create learning environments which nurture self-confidence through use of Lesson Study and Active Research programme;
- To continue to develop the use of Classroom Monitor to enable tracking of Foundation Subjects.

LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT (MANAGEMENT OF SCHOOL CHANGE)

- To further strength Senior Leaders through completion of NPQSL and leading change across the School;
- To further strengthen Foundation Subjects through the development of the Subject Co-ordinators role;
- To continue to explore the move to Academy status with the other Partnership schools involved in the Multi-Academy Trust proposal.
