Morning Tasks	<p>Practise this week's spellings using look, cover, write, check method. Can you practise your cursive handwriting by using each word in a sentence?</p> <p>Daily mental maths: https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/daily10 (Level Six, subtraction)</p> <p>Enjoy reading a chapter of your reading book/ library book aloud and discussing it with a family member.</p>
English	<p>Remind yourselves with what you read in yesterday's lesson. What happened in chapter 2? You need to use the inverted pyramid writing template to summarise chapter 2. First you need to write a clear and concise paragraph that summarises episode 2 and includes all the key information. This will be written in the base (largest section) of the pyramid. Then whittle down your paragraph and try to write a summary of the chapter in only three sentences- can you summarise the chapter in only one sentence? Finally you will write three key words to summarise the chapter. Look at the example on the slide to see how your pyramid will look.</p>
