Write some instructional sentences, using imperative verbs and prepositions, to explain how to get a mammoth out of a tree.

Remember!

Imperative verbs: These are bossy words e.g. Put, get, use, fetch, hold, move etc.

Prepositions: These describe where something is e.g. under, above, over, into, around etc.

Some examples of sentences:

The first thing you need to do to get a mammoth down from a is to find a trampoline.

You then need to carefully drag the trampoline until it is beneath the tree.
