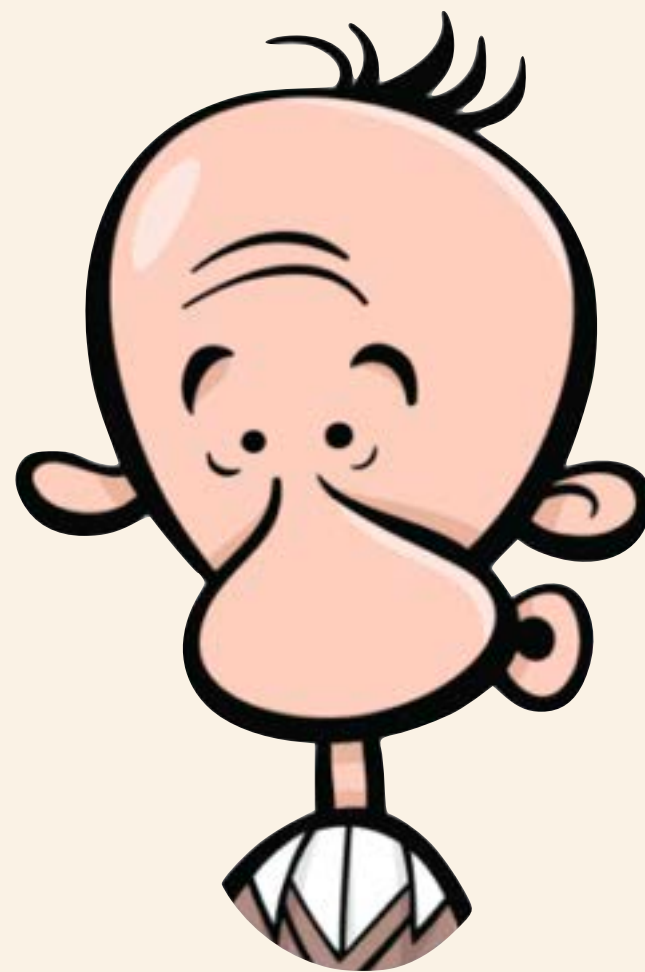


What is the currency of Norway/Sweden/Denmark?
