The phonics link is the same as yesterday as every phonics lesson will begin with reciting the flash cards to build up fluency. A new sound is introduced every few days as and when the children are ready.

Next: Green words are words the children can sound out and blend together. Red words are tricky words which cannot be sounded out and simply need to be remembered. Practise saying green and red words repeatedly over the week.

<u>Green words for the week:</u> From, Well, Such, Rest, Best, Pet, Smell, Must, If Sun

Soft, Hand, Ask, Cap

Red words for the week: What, Do, You, The, I, To

Worksheets: Please find attached.

Proofread: The children will be familiar with proofread as we do this in our phonics lessons. The children are given a sentence which includes spelling and grammar mistakes. The children have to write the sentence out again correcting the mistakes.

Hold a sentence: The children will also be familiar with hold a sentence. The children will hear, read and say a sentence several times. Then they will cover

the sentence and write it out. Once the sentence has been written the children will reveal the sentence and mark their own work.
