Amazing Fact

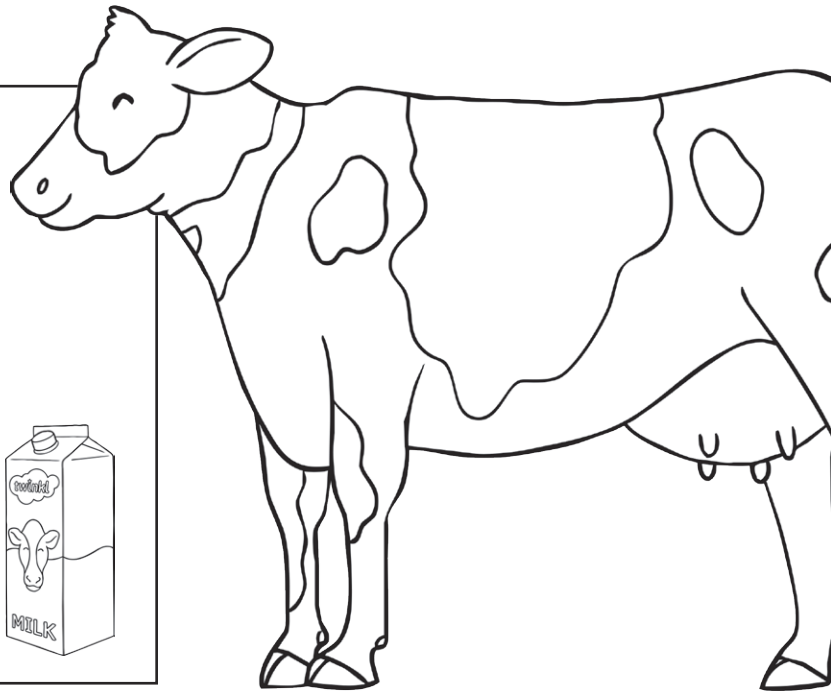
Although humans are the only animals that drink milk as adults naturally, 60% of them cannot properly digest it (their bodies can't break it down).
