Maths	<p>Today's learning objective is to convert fractions to percentages.</p> <p>Watch this video before you begin today's work: https://vimeo.com/492449530</p> <p>Next, go through the PowerPoint slides with an adult and complete the warm-up tasks as you go. Once you've had a go at the tasks on the slides with an adult, see if you can complete the worksheet independently. There are some additional questions on the slides to answer as well.</p>

Science	<p>This week you will be exploring ways of distinguishing between organisms that have similar characteristics. You need to complete either worksheet 2A or 2B. Your task is to think about the different features of the mammals or the birds and how further you could split them into groups. Sort out the cards and stick them onto a large</p>

	piece of paper. Note down the reasons behind your decisions.
