English	<p>Look through the slides to see some examples of real postcards sent from Southampton the day before Titanic departed on her maiden voyage.</p> <p>Today you are going to write a postcard from Johnny to Freddie or Mary. A postcard is a type of recount, so it is written in the first person; just like the diary entry you wrote on Tuesday. Look at the features of postcard writing on the PowerPoint slides. Can you use an informal style to sound more like Johnny?</p>
