We are going to be learning about someone who lived a long time ago!

Somebody famous! She is a local famous person. Local means they lived near us.

We are going to be learning about Grace Darling!

Grace would have had no light bulbs, so at night her only light would have been from a candle. Maybe your adult might close the blinds and light a candle for you to show you what it would have been like for Grace when it gets dark outside.

Grace's life was from very different from ours. She was part of a family of nine children, she didn't go to school but was taught by her father in the lighthouse, they had no running water and had to row to the neighbouring island to collect the vegetables they grew and look after their animals.

If Grace lived so long ago, and she did not have TV, video recorders or any electricity then how can we learn all about her? What can we use to find out some more information? Do you have any ideas?

We can use Photographs, newspaper articles, letters and diaries! Did you guess any? Today we are going to be super investigators using photographs!
