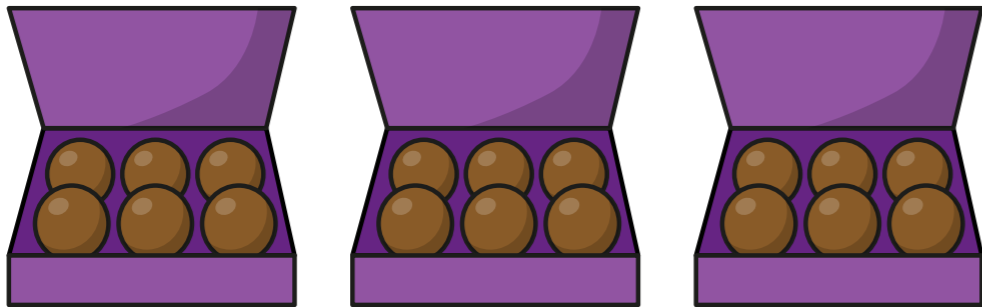


# Multiplication sentences using the $\times$ symbol

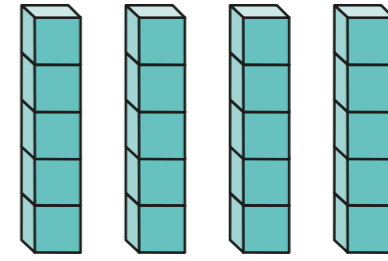
