

Geography

Within this topic we will focus on Geography; particularly, using maps to locate the world's countries, with a focus on Europe (including the location of Russia) and South America, concentrating on their environmental regions, key physical and human characteristics, countries, and major cities. We will also identify the position and significance of latitude, longitude, the Equator and both the Northern Hemisphere and Southern Hemisphere.



English

We will begin this term by looking at a fictional text, which will allow us to continue to develop our prediction and inference skills. This book is not only a literal journey, but focusses a great deal on character development; we will spend time considering how the author shows the reader that the character has changed. We will then study a non-fiction text, linked with our Geography topic. Throughout our study of both texts, we will continue to develop our knowledge of prepositions, subordinate clauses and inverted commas.



DT

Linking with our Science topic of Magnets and Forces, our topic this term is Pneumatics. The children will research products that use pneumatics. They will then design and make their own product, before evaluating their finished creations.

Science

Within Science, we will look at Magnets and Forces, in which we will compare how things move on different surfaces and identify magnetic materials. The children will conduct a range of scientific investigations to enable them to raise their own questions about the world around them.

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Maths

Within Maths, we will begin by focussing on Multiplication and Division. We will then move on to money and then begin to look at statistics.

Music

Throughout the year the children will have a weekly Ukulele lesson taught by a music specialist.

French

We will continue to have French lessons, taught by a specialist French Teacher.

PE

Our focus within PE this term will be Netball, in which we will develop our defending and attacking skills.

RE and P.S.H.E

In RE we will focus on Incarnation and ask the question 'What is the Trinity?'. The children will also take part in Commando Joes this term.

Computing

In Computing, our unit is 'We are Communicators' in which we will learn how to communicate safely on the internet.
