## Speed sounds

Consonants Say the pure sounds (do not add 'uh').

#### Green words

Read in Fred Talk (pure sounds).

not clock stay must yet yes ring

tray day way say

Read in syllables.

San' jay -> Sanjay

an'i'mal -> animal

o`kay → okay
Sting`ray → Stingray

Read the root word first and then with the ending.

play -> played

#### Red words

he all no said you are
