



#### Speed sounds

Read in Fred Talk (pure sounds).

bump switch grin play feel creep might fright night fight right

Read the root word first and then with the ending.

trick -> tricks witch -> witches

gob`lin → goblin

flap -> flapping tuck -> tucked

#### Write about noises:


Have you ever found it hard to sleep because of noises that keep you awake? What would you say to your adult when you cant sleep?
