History & Geography

Pupils will develop a chronologically secure knowledge and understanding of the achievements of one of the earliest civilisations: The Ancient Egyptians. We will conduct an in-depth study of era, exploring Pharaohs, pyramids, Gods, daily life and the work of Egyptologists, such as Howard Carter. Our learning in history will be complemented in our English lessons.

PE

This term, our amazing NUFC Coach, Robbie, will be setting us some weekly challenges. Keep an eye out for his videos which will be available on our Google Classroom.

Maths

This term in maths we will be completing a unit on measurement. We will be converting between units of measure as well as calculating and solving problems involving area, perimeter and volume.

Science

During this half term, pupils will be looking at diet and exercise and the impact their lifestyles can have on their bodies. Children will learn and discuss how drugs and other substances can be harmful to the human body. The children will also have the opportunity to explore the work of scientists and scientific research about the relationship between diet. exercise, drugs, lifestyle and health. Our Science learning objectives will be complemented in our PSHE lessons.

Computing This term, pupils will be discovering what a 'Text Adventure' game is, and how to create their own! They will use a well-known story as a stimulus that has many different scenarios to chose from. Which path will they follow and how will their story end?

Music In music, we will be learning about rhythm. The focus will be learning about what syncopation means and to build our knowledge and understanding of this term in order compose a syncopated rhythm of their own.

French

Over the next few weeks, we will be picking up our detective kits to examine links from French with other languages. This will develop strategies to give in-depth knowledge of etymology (language origins) and links to the potential study of German or Spanish at secondary school.

English

Our work over the next term will centre around the novel, Secrets of a Sun King by Emma Carroll. We will be exploring plot and character as well as generating our own Egyptian-inspired creative writing. During this book study, we will be deepening and developing various reading strategies such as questioning, prediction, inference and visualisation. Our spelling, punctuation and grammar objectives will be taught within the context of the book and our non-fiction work will complement our learning in history lessons.

RE & PSHE

Our RE topic for Autumn term is SALVATION - we will be exploring what difference the resurrection makes for Christians. In PSHE, we will be exploring a balanced lifestyle and what it means to have a healthy body and mind.
