

THE UK AND GREECE

Year 3 Summer 2 2021



Computing

In Computing this half term, we will focus on coding, using the Purple Mash resources.

Geography

During this half term, we will be focussing on geographical similarities and differences through the study of human and physical geography of a region of the United Kingdom and a region in Greece.

Science

During this half term, we will focus on health and nutrition. We will be learning that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food.

Music

We will continue to have Ukulele lessons, taught by a specialist teacher on a Friday. We will also have music lessons on a Thursday.

Maths

Within Maths, we will continue to focus on time for the first week. We will then move on to look at properties of shape, in which we will learn about right angles, parallel and perpendicular lines and recognise and describe 3D shapes. We will then look at mass and capacity.

RE/ PSHE

In RE, our topic is 'Hinduism'.

In PSHE, we have 2 topics. For the first 3 weeks, we will focus on RSE. This will involve us learning about the main differences between male and female bodies, appropriate and inappropriate physical contact and to explore different types of families.

Then for the last 3 weeks, our topic will be 'Smoking', which will link to our Science topic, in which we will be learning about staying healthy. Within this topic, we will consider why people smoke, how it affects people and to learn strategies to prevent smoking.

DT

Our unit within DT is 'Sandwich snacks'. We will be evaluating existing products, such as sandwich fillers and different types of bread, before designing and making our own healthy sandwich. We will then evaluate our sandwiches against the design criteria.

PE

We will have 2 PE lessons per week, on Tuesdays and Fridays. One of those sessions will focus on net and wall games. The other session will focus primarily on fitness.

English

During this half term, we will begin by exploring a fiction text, with a focus being on prediction and inference. We will use this text to write in a range of different genres. We will then move on to study a non-fiction text. In the final weeks, we will explore a short fiction text, focussing on descriptive language.

French

We will continue to have French lessons, taught by a specialist French Teacher.
