

This half term, Year 1 will be learning...

English

Read Write Inc will be taught daily incorporating spelling, punctuation and spelling knowledge. The children will have a focus on handwriting where they will continue form letters using lead in lines. Children will apply their writing skills through other subject areas within the topic. We will focus on a variety of narrative and non-fiction books that link to our topic, as well as poetry.

Science

During this topic children will focus on seasonal changes. We will look at why we have seasons and what changes occur because of them. We will also look at the weather in the UK as well as how the length of the day varies.

Maths

Children will continue developing their skills in shape and number. This half term we will be learning about measurements where we will be focusing on weight, volume, length and height. We will also look at money where we will focus on coin recognition and counting in coins.

PSHE

Children will learn about physical health and mental wellbeing. Within this unit of work, the children will look at how to keep themselves healthy. We will also look at breathing and mindfulness.

Superheroes!



History

In History the children will be looking at their own family history and the heroes in their family. We will be learning about real life heroes like Neil Armstrong and life changing events such as the moon landing.

R.E

In R.E. the children will be learning about Judaism. We will be looking at Jewish festivals and lifestyles. We will be learning about shabbat and the Passover in detail.

Art

Children will be focusing on the artist Roy Lichtenstein. They will be creating their own superhero pop art in the style of his work using mixed media.

Music

In music children will focus on songs in preparation for the Platinum Jubilee as well as learning about music appreciation.

P.E

Children will be taught by specialist coaches from NUFC for 1 lesson per week. The other lesson will be focusing on ball skills including throwing, catching, hitting and striking.

Computing

Children will begin to think logically about scenarios and will be introduced to the term 'algorithm'. This concept is at the core of coding. They will be following and creating simple instructions as well as correcting errors.
