Parental Survey - March 2023

Results of the Survey

About the Questionnaire

Background

- A Parental Survey exercise was undertaken in order to assess current parental satisfaction with key areas of school provision;
- The questions themselves were drawn from the new OFSTED questions used on the ParentView website;
- The questionnaire was provided to all parents during the Parent's Evenings on 7th and 9th March 2023. Respondents could complete the questionnaire while at school and place it into the collections box or take it home and returns were to be in school by Monday 13th March 2023;
- Respondents were assured of complete anonymity;
- Parents were provided with a series of statements about the school and were asked to choose from the following responses in each case:
 Strongly agree, agree, disagree, strongly disagree, don't know;
- Respondents were also given the opportunity to add written comments.

Response

- 103 questionnaires were returned representing 151 pupils, approximately 67% of the number of children on roll;
- The breakdown of pupils by year group was as follows:

'The School supports my child's wider development.'


'The School lets me know how my child is doing.'

'There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this School.'


'My child has SEND and the School gives them the support they need to succeed.'


All concerns raised are taken seriously by the school.


The school is very grateful to those parents who participated in the survey.





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












Comments on 'what we do well'

Comments on 'what we could do better'

Several constructive comments were made on a number of issues:

COMMUNICATION

- Still receive lots (too many) emails not relevant to our children's year group;
- PDF attachments are the wrong format for delivering this content;
- More advance notice of key dates;
- I like the Friday Flyer. Information on key dates for term could be in here.

Where possible the School will try to ensure that emails are sent to the year groups that information pertains to, however, there may be occasions where it is felt that the information should be shared more widely with the parent body. This is an area which the School continues to work on.

In terms of format of information the School is trying to limit the number of messages containing attachments and providing information within the body of the message itself. Should further information be required from parents, such as a signature, there may be a need to send an attachment. Due to the size limitations of the messaging software and security of the information being sent (to prevent amendment) PDF format is the preferred file format. Over the year the School will look to place attachments as a post on the News Section of the School Website and provide a link within the body of the sent message to enable people to access it easily as we currently do with the Friday Flyer.

The School does set the calendar as far in advance as possible and we try our best to share this information as soon as possible. The School seeks to provide information in a timely manner, however, there is always a possibility of dates needing to change. Therefore the School has now put a dates for the term section into the weekly Friday Flyer to keep parents as up to date as possible with dates. Moving forwards any changes to dates will be highlighted to parents in this section.

BULLYING

 Concern if complaints around bullying are fed back to parents or just dealt with internally

CLUBS

No extra curricular clubs for Reception

Reception children are still young and have a long and busy day in School and are often tired, particularly in the Autumn term, however, the School will continue to keep this under review.

ART

• Would like to see the children working with a wider range of materials in Art

The School has been working hard to develop the offered curriculum in all subjects over the last few years. The Art curriculum has been changed to ensure a balance of skills and techniques covered each year which is then built upon in subsequent years. Alongside drawing and painting, children will study sculpture using a variety of media, printing using a variety of media from polystyrene tiles to making our own lino printing blocks, architecture including relief and bas-relief and techniques such as decoupage.

Art club in Key Stage 1 is also exploring using different materials.

FEEDBACK

- Do sometimes feel that individual feedback is quite general but teachers are approachable and always happy to listen, offer advice and suggestions;
- It would be nice to see more Tapestry information about what the Nursery children have been doing as otherwise we don't get much out of our child! But I appreciate it is time consuming for staff.

Staff in School know the children well and will always provide appropriate feedback. If there are any areas of your child's School life that parents wish to know more about the Staff are always willing to speak to parents. You can either speak to your child's class teacher by making an appointment via the School Office or you can email them directly using the class email address. The School tries to strike a balance with Tapestry in providing information about what the children are doing and the time that it takes to do this.
