





































We have had such a lovely first week in The Owls' Class getting to know each other and exploring our new classroom.



Heidi sent us a lovely picture which made us all smile of her dog, Kit, celebrating winning 'the dog with the waggiest tail' award at the show!








Thanks for our Armed Forces Day Donation




