In our classroom we have a lovely, cosy reading area.

We have small world and construction toys.





We have a big creative area where you paint or make models. We also have a role play area too. This changes throughout the year. This is our outdoor classroom where we can run, climb, investigate and explore all sorts of things!







There are toilets in our classroom and you can go anytime you need to. There are sinks and hand dryers for you to wash and dry your hands. If you have a little accident, tell a grown up so we can help you. You might want to bring some named spare clothes with you, just in case.

We ask that you bring a **named** filled water bottle **daily**.



Our school day begins at 8:55am. I will greet you each morning with smile ... don't forget to bring your smile too!

Our cloakroom is just beside the main door. Each morning you will find your peg and hang up your coat, bag and packed lunch (if you bring one).





We also have a box each to keep our wellies safe. It will be very useful to keep a pair of **named** wellies in school.
