This half term, Year 1 will be learning...

English

Read Write Inc will be taught daily incorporating spelling, punctuation and spelling knowledge. The children will have a focus on handwriting where they will begin form letters using lead in lines. Children will apply their writing skills through other subject areas within the topic. We will focus on a variety of narrative and non-fiction books that link to our topic, as well as poetry.

Science

During this topic children will focus on animals (including humans). As part of this topic we will look at naming body parts, exploring our senses as well as beginning to look at animals, starting with mammals and birds.

Maths

Children will continue developing their skills in number. This half term we will be focusing on place value within 10 as well as addition and subtraction within 10. Taking a mastery approach, children will have a deeper understanding of numbers, their worth and be able to manipulate numbers appropriately to solve problems and calculations.

PSHE

Children will learn about families and friendships, focusing on the roles of different people and feeling cared for. We will also look at safe relationships where children will learn to recognise privacy and seek permission.

R.E

In R.E. the children will be learning about what Christians believe God is like. We will be focusing on the parable of the Lost Son.

Computing

Children will be taught how to log onto the Chromebooks and into Purplemash using their usernames and passwords as well as looking at e-safety.

Art

Children will be focusing on elements of art where they will practise using a range of drawing materials, will draw different types of lines and will practise creating observational drawings.

P.E

Children will be team taught by Mr Smith (specialist PE teacher) and Miss Robinson for 1 lesson per week, with a follow-up lesson being taught by Miss Robinson. This half-term will be focussed upon invasion game skills.

Music

In music children will be taught singing, notation and rhythms by Mrs Milner, in their weekly lesson.

Geography

In Geography the children will look at maps and aerial photographs of our classroom, our school and the local area. We will also go on a walk around the local area and will focus upon local human and physical geographical features.
