

## During Autumn 1, Year 2 will be learning...

### English

Read Write Inc or Literature Works will be taught daily incorporating reading, punctuation, grammar and spelling knowledge. Children who have completed Read Write Inc will take part in SCODE spelling sessions. The children will also take part in regular whole-class guided reading sessions as well as being heard to read individually. We will focus on a variety of narrative and non-fiction books that link to our topic, as well as poetry.

### Maths

Children will continue developing their skills in number, counting, partitioning and calculation with a focus on place value this half term. Taking a mastery approach, children will have a deeper understanding of numbers and their worth and be able to manipulate numbers appropriately to solve problems and calculations. Each day children will take part in a mastering number session which aims to improve number fluency.

### Art

In Art children will explore colour, texture and pattern to create pictures of living things. We will focus on the artist David Hockney and his painting of landscapes.

### Science

During this topic children will be learning about animals, including humans. We will focus on what all animals need to survive, what we mean by offspring, how exercise and diet can impact upon us and why hygiene is important.

### Music

In Music, Mrs Milner will deliver the Kodaly approach to teach notation, rhythm and pitch through a variety of songs, rhymes and games.

### Computing

Children will be taught to use technology safely and respectfully and will begin to recognise the importance of keeping personal information private.

### P.E

Mr Smith (our specialist PE teacher) and Mrs Abbott will teach invasion game skills during this half term. We will focus on ball skills, intercepting an opponent, adapting throws for certain distances and attacking and defending tactics.

### Geography

In Geography the children will look at the landscapes around us and use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to it. Through looking at maps and aerial photographs they will develop their geographical skills and fieldwork.

### R.E & PSHE

In R.E. we will be learning about creation and what Christians believe about this area. In PSHE we will be exploring new beginnings and settling into new classroom routines.
