This half term in Year 2 we will be learning...

English

Read Write Inc or Literature Works will be taught daily incorporating reading, punctuation, grammar and spelling knowledge. The children will also take part in regular wholeclass guided reading sessions as well as being heard to read individually. We will focus on a variety of narrative and non-fiction books that link to our topic, as well as poetru.

Music

In Music, Mrs Milner will deliver the Kodaly approach to teach notation, rhythm and pitch through a variety of songs, rhymes and games.

Computing

Children will be taught to use technology safely and respectfully and will begin to recognise the importance of keeping personal information private.

Maths

Children will continue developing their skills in number, counting, partitioning and calculation with a focus on place value this half term. Taking a mastery approach, children will have a deeper understanding of numbers and their worth and be able to manipulate numbers appropriately to solve problems and calculations. Each day children will take part in a mastering number session which aims to improve number fluency.
