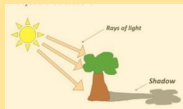


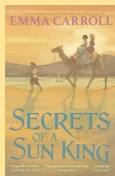
In Science this half term we will be learning about light. We will understand how light travels, how shadows are formed and how we see objects.



In Maths this half term we will be revising the full curriculum in preparation for our SATs tests. Our lessons will be structured into arithmetic and reasoning revision, as we recap our learning from right across Key Stage 2.



In English, we will continue to finish reading Holes, before moving onto Emma Carroll's "Secrets of a Sun King". We will use this book to inspire our writing outcomes, as well as our reading skills. We will write a narrative, a discussion and an advertisement piece.



In PSHE lessons we will be exploring lessons on positive thinking, re-framing our thought processes and begin to discuss how we can be successful in transitioning to high school.

In PE we will be playing cricket and rounders. We will practise our batting, bowling and fielding skills, and learn how to bat in different ways.



In French we will be using our language to order ice creams, pizzas and drinks at the cafe /restaurant. We will also be talking about our favourite foods



In DT we will be creating our own frame structures, learning about how best to reinforce our structures through the use of triangulation.

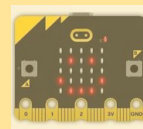
Exploring Africa!
