

Year 1 Summer Term 1: Paddington's London Adventure!



English

Read Write Inc will be taught daily incorporating spelling, punctuation, and Spelling knowledge. The children will have a focus on handwriting where they will continue to form letters using lead in and lead out lines. Children will apply their writing skills through other subyct areas within the topic. We will focus on a variety of narrative and non-fiction books that link to our topic.

Geography

In Geography the children will look at the geographical features of London and its famous landmarks. The children will then be comparing London to Heddon on the Wall. We will also learn the four capital cities in the United Kingdom.

Maths

Our focus in maths will be on multiplication and division, in which we will be counting consistently in 2's, 5's and 10's.

We will also learn about money and what each note and coin represents.

DT

In DT the children will learn how to make their own freestanding structure and how to increase its stability.

Science

During this topic children will be learning about plants, including growing a seed, labelling parts of a plant and naming common garden and wildflower plants.

We will also look at identifying evergreen and deciduous trees.

Computing

Children will be continuing to make their own animated stories.

As well as beginning to learn how to code.

R.E and PSHCE

In R.E. the children will be taught about Judaism and we will be exploring the importance and meaning of Shabbot and Hanukkah for the Jewish people.

In PSHE we will be focusing on our physical health and our mental wellbeing.

P.E

Children will be team taught by Mr Walker (NUF Foundation Coach) and Miss Robinson for 1 lesson per week, with a follow-up lesson being taught by Miss Robinson.

Our focus will be on striding and fielding game skills.

Music

In music children will be taught singing, natation, beats and rhythms by Mrs Milner in their weekly lesson.

We will also be listening to and discussing a range of different music from musicals as part of our music appreciation sessions.
